



## Bus Driver

Drives vehicle to provide on demand urban public transportation services to the community of people with disabilities and those who are elderly in Abilene, Tx. Public Transportation services are provided between 8:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Approximately 30 hours weekly.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

Drive vehicle to provide demand response curb to curb transportation to the residents of its service area with door-to-door service available for elderly and people with disabilities upon request and determination of need.

Enter and exit vehicles at each stop to assist or aid customers.

Always operate vehicle in a safe manner.

Perform daily safety inspections to ensure that vehicles are always in good operating conditions. Reports problems found during daily safety inspection or that occur during operation of vehicle to supervisor.

Report to assigned work location to obtain daily manifest and other correspondence from administrative office.

Abide by daily schedule.
